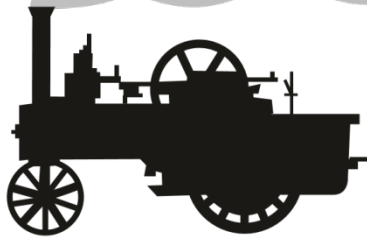

# Conditions of Entry

- **Insurance** My Entry will be covered by a public liability insurance, including Rally use, having a limit of indemnity of not less than £1,000,000 for any one accident. I further declare that in the case of any event taking place wholly or partly on the Public Highway, that the vehicle hereby entered is covered by insurances as required by the Road Traffic Act 1960, which is valid for such part of this event as shall take place on roads as defined by the Act. I confirm that the driver(s) of any such vehicles entered, holds a license and is not disqualified from holding or obtaining a license to drive the vehicle of the appropriate class.
- The carriage of passengers on agricultural tractors is prohibited unless the tractor is fitted, by design, with additional seating.
- Carrying of passengers in Link Boxes is Prohibited.
- Carrying of passengers in trailers is prohibited except at the discretion of the organizer.
- Please comply with directives and requests from organizers, section stewards and marshals.
- Please observe the site speed limit of 5mph for all vehicles.
- Please adhere to the campsite rules as displayed at campsite entrance.
- Vehicle movement on site between 10:00am and 5:00pm only as directed by section stewards and marshals.
- Vehicle movement on the site is prohibited from 12:00 midnight to 7:00am except as agreed by security staff. In emergency please use the contact telephone number displayed at campsite entrances.
- Exhibits must remain on display from 10am until 5pm Saturday and Sunday. Taking part in their section parades and in the final grand parade, as requested, unless previously agreed with section steward.
- A completed vehicle pass or exhibitor number must be displayed at all times.
- The Exhibitors Gate closes at 10:00am. After this time all vehicles arriving will be sent to the vehicle holding area.
- Exhibitors may leave the site by the Exhibitors entrance at 5:30pm Saturday: 5:00pm Sunday.

## **Somerset Traction Engine Club (STEC) Privacy Notice - Important, Please Read**

The General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) came into force on 25 May 2018 and as a club which stores personal data, we need to comply with these. This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us.

This privacy notice applies from the time you give consent for your data to be held. It explains how we collect, store and use the personal information that you provide to us.

By completing this entry form you give consent for us to hold your personal data. Your personal data is collected and processed for the purposes of sending you STEC rally entry forms, information in respect of the rally and occasionally a copy of the members news sheet.

The data collected and stored is your name, address, telephone number, exhibit details, business name (if appropriate) and email (if given).

We are committed to keeping your personal data safe and we have procedures in place to secure your personal information. Your data is stored on encrypted, password protected, pen drives. Where we hold data in paper format, we ensure it is held securely in a locked container or filing cabinet.

Your data (name and address only) may be shared with our print company to enable them to post any newsletter or similar.

Your personal data will never be sold or used for marketing purposes.

Please keep us up to date with changes to your personal information we hold about you.

You may request to have any inaccuracies in the personal information about you corrected.

You may view the data held on yourself at any time, with reasonable notice.

You may request that your data is erased at any time by contacting the Rally Secretary, however this will mean that you will no longer receive any information as set out above or rally entry forms.
