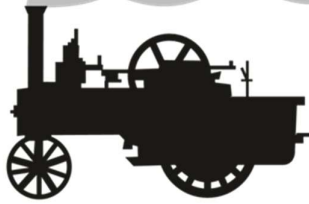

Conditions of Entry

• **Insurance** I/We declare that during the whole period of the rally, my/our entry will be covered by a public liability policy of insurance including rally use and by a boiler explosion policy, both policies having a limit of indemnity of not less than £5000000 for any one accident and sparks and ashes cover for not less than £20000. I/We also declare that in the case of the event taking place wholly or partly on the public highway, that the vehicle hereby entered is covered by insurance as required by the road traffic act 1960, which is valid for such parts of this event as shall take place on roads as defined by the act. I/We further declare that the boiler or any steam plant entered carries a current board of trade inspection certificate and I will produce documentary evidence of such inspection to you on request. I/We confirm that the driver/s of any such vehicles entered holds and is not disqualified from holding or obtaining a license to drive the vehicle of the appropriate class. As the Somerset Steam and Country Show is a N.T.E.T. approved event, please display a current N.T.E.T. insurance/ boiler inspection disc.

- Carrying of passengers in trailers is prohibited except at the discretion of the organiser.
- Please comply with directives and requests from organisers, section stewards and marshals.
- Please observe the site speed limit of 5mph for all vehicles.
- Please adhere to the campsite rules as displayed at campsite entrance.
- Vehicle movement on site between 10:00am and 5:00pm only as directed by section stewards and marshals.
- Vehicle movement on the site is prohibited from 12:00 midnight to 7:00am except as agreed by security staff. In emergency please use the contact telephone number displayed at campsite entrances.
- Exhibits must remain on display from 10am until 5pm Saturday and Sunday and take part in steam parades and final grand parade, unless previously agreed with section steward.
- A completed vehicle pass or exhibitor number must be displayed at all times.
- The Exhibitors Gate closes at 10:00am. After this time all vehicles arriving will be sent to the vehicle holding area.
- Exhibitors may leave the site by the Exhibitors entrance at 5:30pm Saturday: 5:00pm Sunday.
- By signing this form I give consent for the STEC to hold my personal data and agree to our privacy policy
